Pancake Thursday!

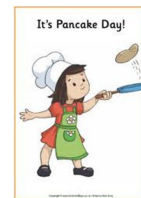
The P&C have funds available to provide the students a FREE pancake lunch on Thursday 11 April.

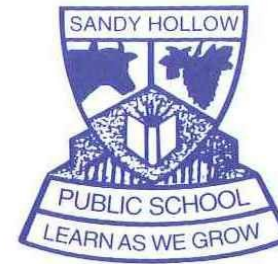

busy timetable, we are unable to fit it in later in the year. The P&C were to pay for this activity in full, so that money will now be set aside for another whole school activity.
