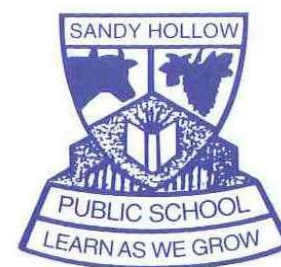
Archie swam in:
