

Sandy Hollow Students Help Save the Regent Honeyeater.

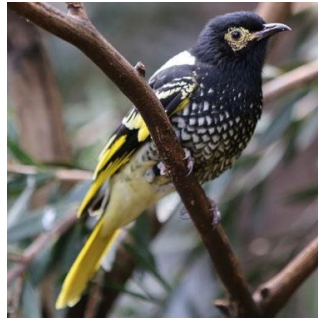
The Regent Honeyeater is a bird found in our local area that is about to become extinct. It eats the nectar from iron bark trees.

On 24th March Sandy Hollow students went to Merriwa Central School to participate in a Taronga Zoo visit. During the visit we talked to Dan and Jackie. Jackie talked about habitat and how it can be destroyed. Dan discussed the location of the project. He told us about the new fence they put in and how they turned up the soil for planting the trees.

Tomorrow, 31st March, Years 5 & 6 from Sandy Hollow and Merriwa Central are going to Worond Road to create a habitat for the Regent Honeyeater. This is a very important project because there are less than 500 left in Australia.

The students are very excited to participate in this important conservation project.

Class News Year 2

This term Year 2 have been very busy. In writing we have focused on persuasive writing. We have looked at different types of advertising and the language used to persuade the reader. We are now starting to look at the structure and grammatical features of a persuasive text.

In English we are reading "Tom Tom" by Rosemary Sullivan. During these sessions we have explored how the author uses adjectives to make the sentences more interesting. Year 2 have identified nouns, proper nouns and pronouns used in the story. We have identified different uses for a comma and written sentences using a comma. We are currently working on how to write different types of sentences. In mathematics Year 2 are focusing on the investigation "Gone Fishing". During this time students will work on whole numbers, numbers beyond 100, addition facts, subtraction facts, mental strategies for addition and subtraction, division, measurement, months and seasons.

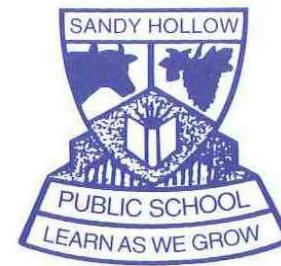
All children will need to be at school by 8.30 with their hats on. Please ensure your child has plenty of water to drink. Please bring recess and lunch if you have not previously ordered.
