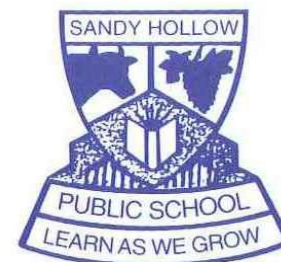

What's Happening in the Infants at Sandy Hollow

All the children should be very proud of themselves for their individual achievements at the cross country last Friday and for their behaviour.

In the classroom the children have worked extremely well all the term.

Kindergarten's sounds and sight word knowledge is very impressive. The children enjoy using the interactive whiteboard to complete a variety of activities on each sound and sight word. Year 1 students are growing in confidence as writers as we focus on sentence structure.

During maths Year 1 has been studying their investigation entitled 'All About Birthdays'. Kindergarten have focussed on the 'Good Night Sleep Tight' investigation. These investigations foster deeper understanding of mathematical concepts as the children use critical and creative thinking skills within real life mathematical contexts.

Throughout the term we have used a variety of mediums to create art works of spotted fish and fireworks. As you can see from the photos the children achieved wonderful results.
