

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COVID-19 update

The latest advice from the Department of Education in regards to COVID-19 restrictions state that:

Parents and carers can enter the school to:

- purchase or pick up uniforms from the
- uniform shop
- meet with school staff with an appointment (including meetings for prospective students)
- drop off students to their classes for Preschool, Kindergarten and Years 1, 2 and 7 for the first few days of school provided they following physical distancing and hygiene measures implemented by the school and the Department. Parents and carers may also enter the school to pick up students for the first few days based on each school's arrangements for these year groups.
- attend parent orientation meetings for Department Preschools, Kindergarten or Year 7 and 'meet the teacher' meetings with school staff for all year/stage groups. Meetings should be limited to 1 hour where possible. <u>A COVID-19 Safety Plan</u> must be in place.

All visitors to the school, regardless of the reason, must sign in using the displayed QR code and show a staff member the tick to verify the check-in (on the Service NSW app), they must also sign an *external visitor to school site form* (these forms are at the office). If parents are onsite as volunteers for a particular service to the school, they must also sign the visitor's book located in the office.

Hopefully these restrictions will ease in the near future, but at this stage, we are still unable to hold assemblies or other events with parents on site. I will keep you updated via the fortnightly newsletters of any updates as they arise.


